



HOW TO POUR A DRAFT BEER

1

If available, use a glass-rinser to remove any debris.

Place a room temperature glass at a 45 degree angle one inch below the faucet. Do not let the glass touch the faucet.



2

Grab the tab handle at the base, so to put the least amount of pressure on the faucet, and open the faucet in one swift motion.



3

Once the glass is two-thirds full, gradually bring the glass back to its upright position.

Let the remaining beer run straight down the middle to ensure the formation of a 1 inch foam head.



4

Close the faucet quickly and completely. Enjoy!
